Birds, Bees and Butterflies at Bluestem

Dying to know what's flying around at Bluestem??!

Join Bluestem Volunteer and birdwatcher Noah Rokoske for a two hour wander around Bluestem's pathways and emerging hiking trail. Bring your best walking shoes, sun hat, binoculars, and water bottle. Get ready to spot wildflowers filled with Monarchs, Eastern Tiger Swallowtails, Indigo Buntings, Vireos and Bluebirds.

We'll gather at the front of the property at 8:30am, provide a short welcome, offer up a few species spotting challenges, and take off into the interior grasslands and woodlands. You'll experience wide open skies, flitting creatures, and all of nature's busy sounds. Pathways are mostly flat, wide, grassy, and sometimes irregular. Bring walking sticks or hiking poles if you like them. Or, select a natural one from a collection in the woods that Noah has been stacking.

This is a first come first served event, with a cap of 30 participants. Kids are welcome. While we do love dogs, this is an event only for their owners. We have a portapotty onsite but no formal bathrooms nor running water. Please plan accordingly.
