


DIRECTIONS TO BLUESTEM 1900 Hurdle Mills Road Cedar Grove, NC 27231



Bluestem is a place of reverence in nature with ongoing land restoration, a hiking network for mindful recreation, and a conservation cemetery for natural burial. It is a nonprofit 501c3 operated by Bluestem Community www.bluestemcommunitync.org.

Bluestem sits on Occaneechi land. Learn more about the Occaneechi Band of the Saponi Nation online: www.obsn.org.

Be sure to enter Cedar Grove when typing the address into GPS. Both Google and Apple Maps have been programmed with the address but occasionally send visitors to a gate up the road or to the same address in Roxboro (25 minutes away).

Two ways of approach from Hillsborough:

- North on Hwy 86, right at Caviness Jordan for 2 miles, right at Hurdle Mills, 1000 ft on the left.
- North on Hwy 86, right at Hurdle Mills Road for 2.3 miles, Bluestem on the left.

Bluestem's entrance is somewhat hidden by a tree line and visitors frequently overshoot it.

Visitor Parking

In the front parking area before the cedar fence. Overflow is just past the cedar fence on the left.

Parking for Burial Services

Along the main farm road or in an area designated by staff. Guests will be directed by Bluestem volunteers. Thank you for dropping your speed and watching for pedestrians on Bluestem Road. Speed Limit is 5mph.
